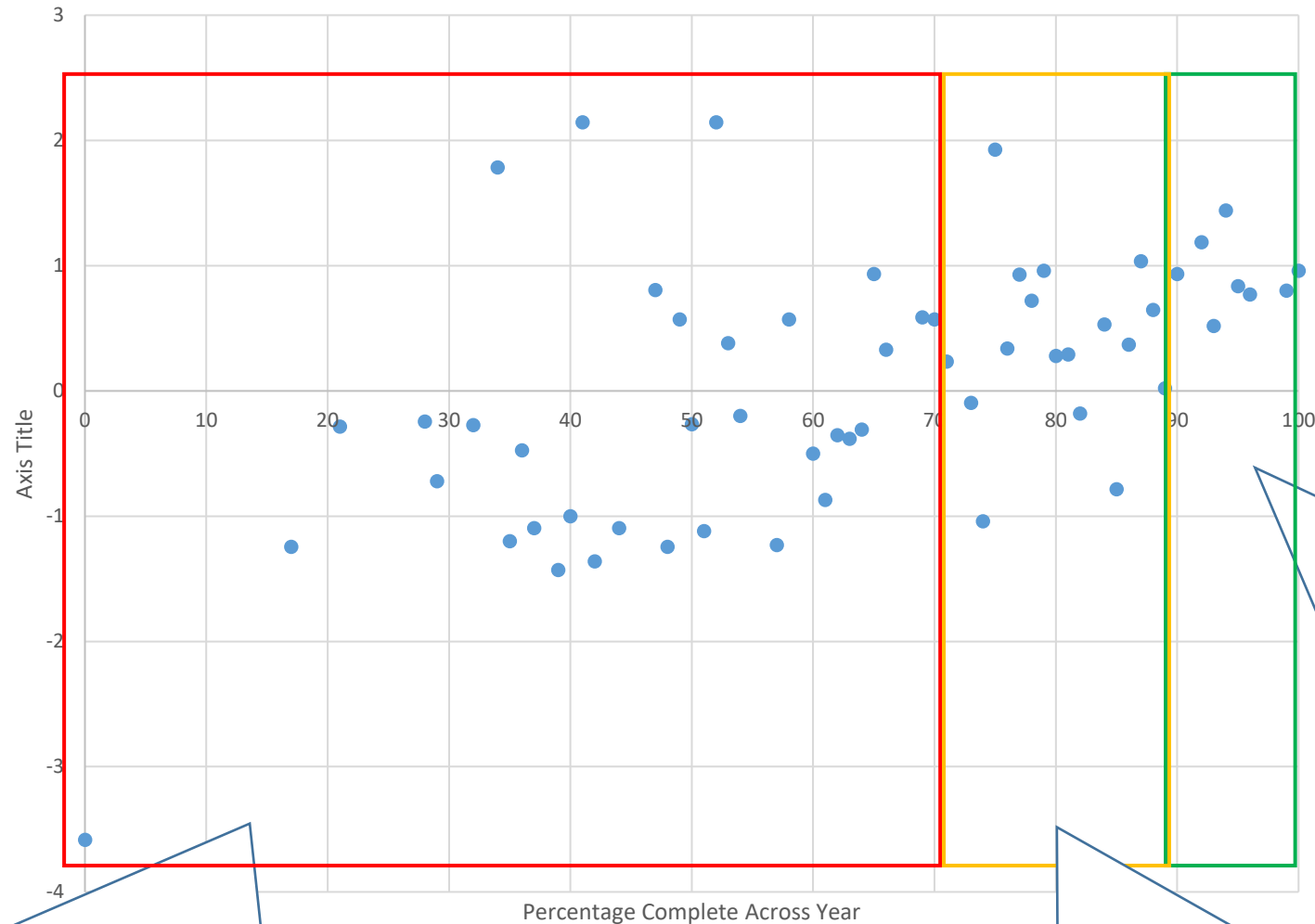

Progress in 2024 Mathematics vs Percentage Completion across year

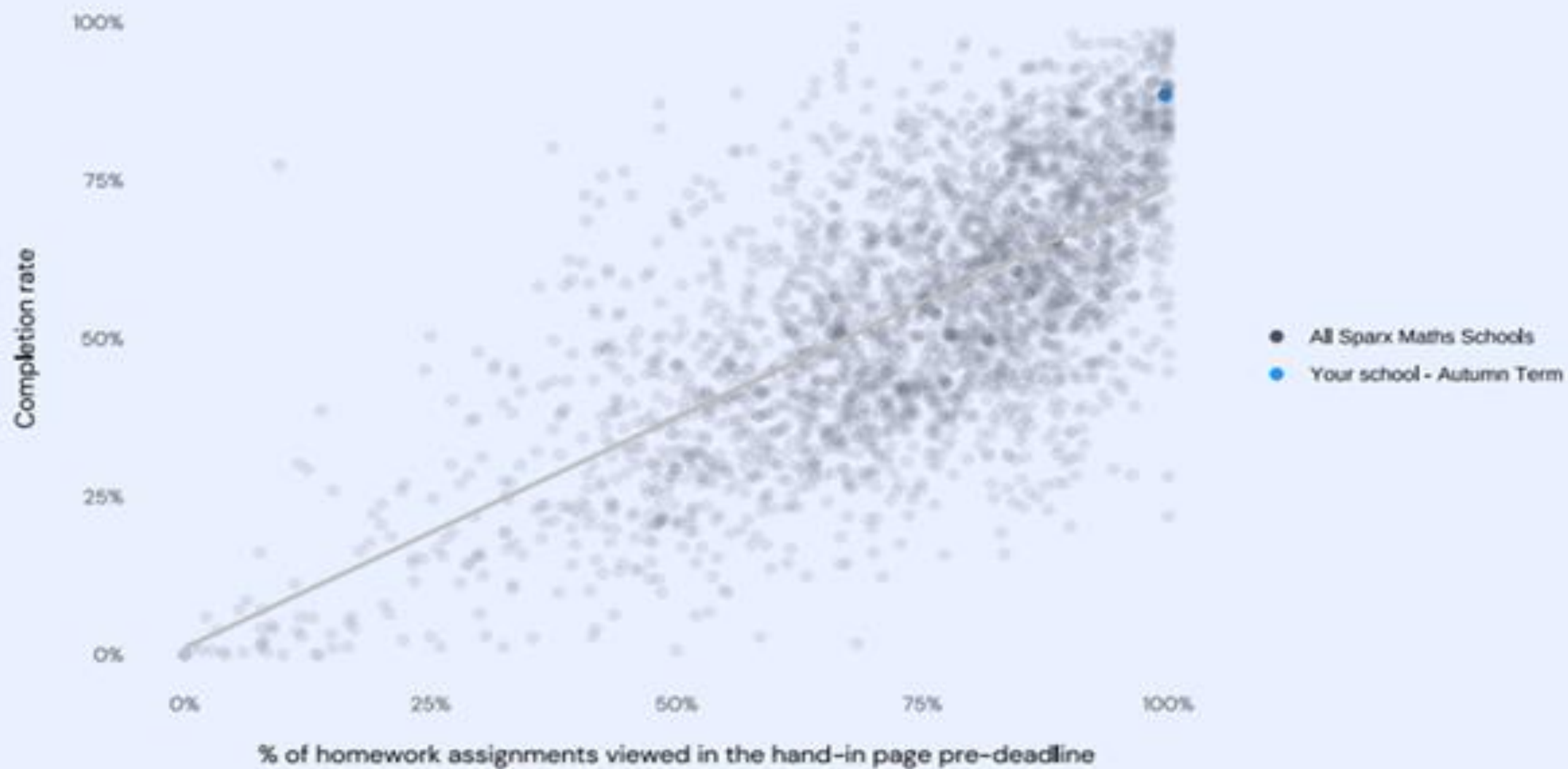


At above 90% completion across the year – average progress was above zero for all learners at +0.86 – on average they were a close to a full grade higher than expected.

Below 70% the average progress was -0.34. These students got close to half a grade lower than expected.

From 70-90% completion the average progress was +0.46 close to half a grade better than expected.

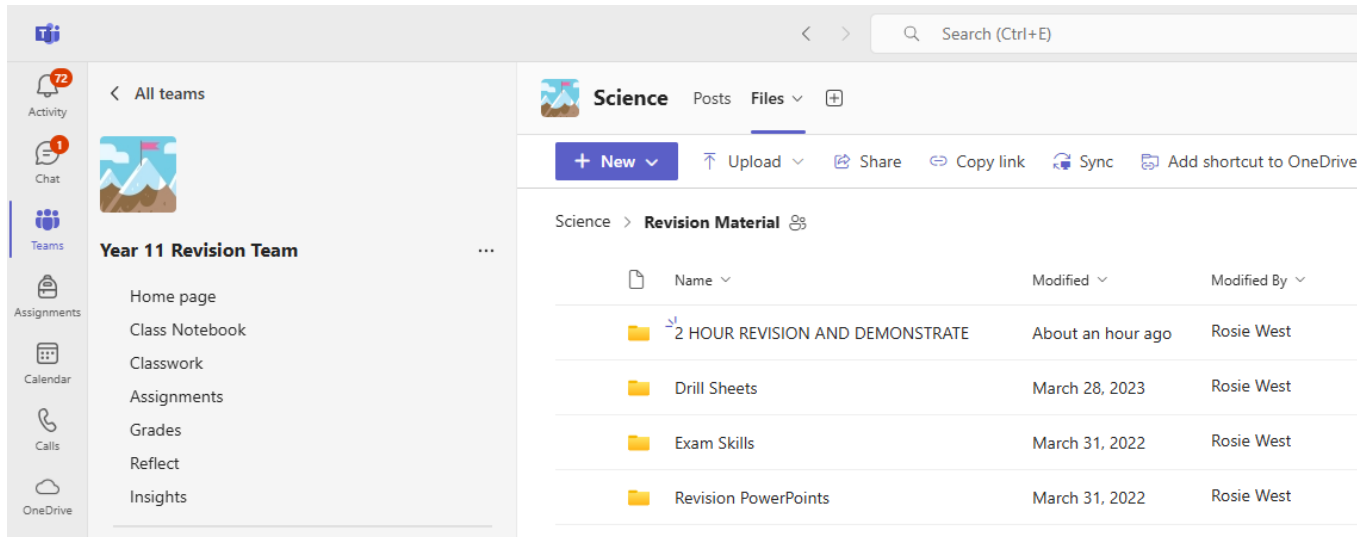

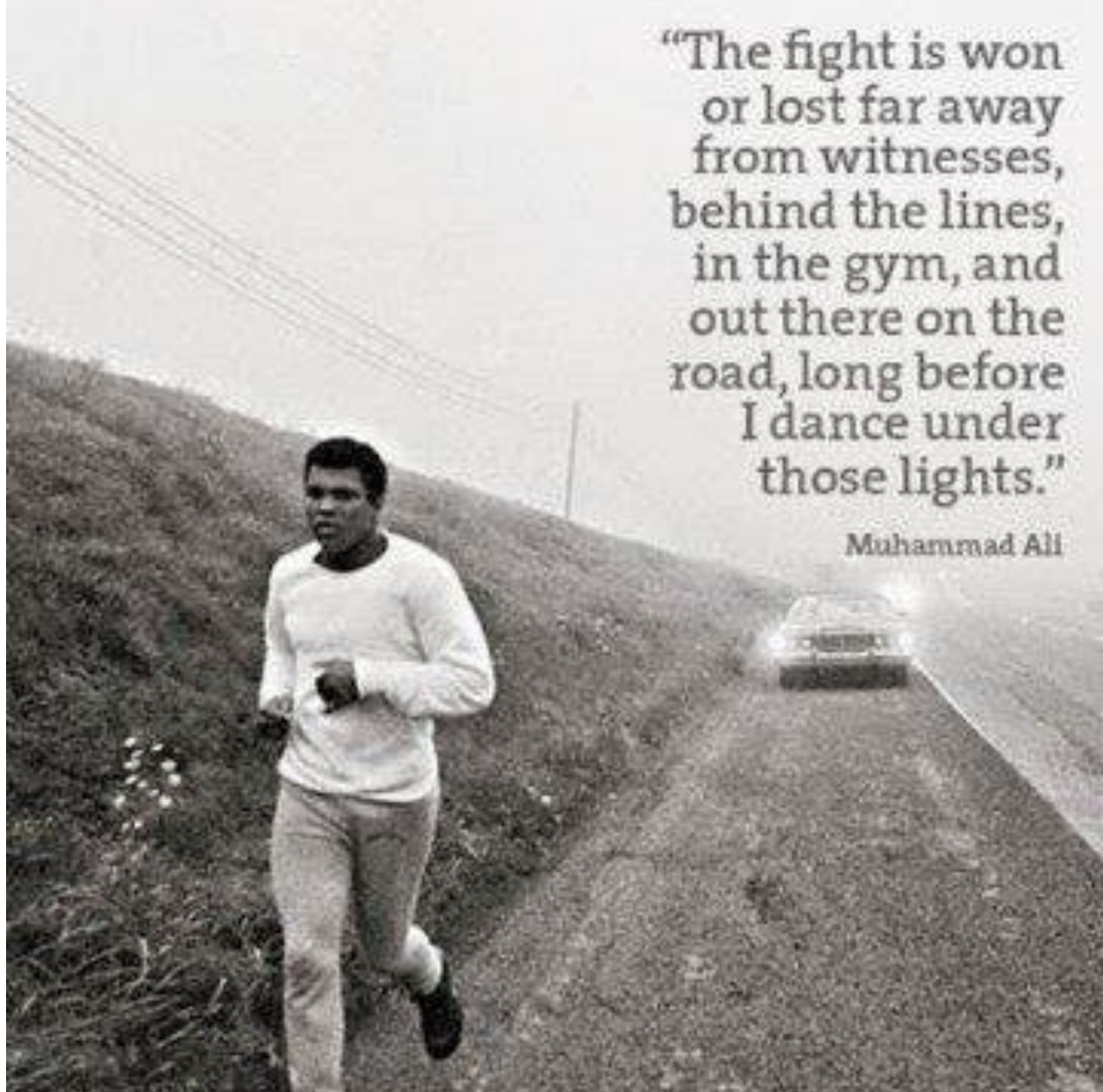
